

# BHS SAT PREP CLASS



**What:** A course designed to prepare juniors and seniors for SAT success

**When:** **MATH** Tuesdays 2:30-4:30pm or 6:00-8:00pm

**ENGLISH:** Wednesdays 2:30-4:30pm or 6:00-8:00pm

**ENGLISH:** Thursdays 3:00-5:00pm or 6:00-8:00pm

**Cost:** \$125/class for each class: English and Math

## **Course Description:**

Students will receive instruction both on SAT test-taking strategies and on required skills for the Critical Reading/Writing and Math sections of the NEW SAT. Upon enrollment, students will receive a text of practice problems and practice tests. The course will be taught by trained teachers in both English and Math. Students who successfully complete both courses will earn one academic credit. The class is designed to further student's SAT test-taking skills and to promote their overall achievement on the NEW SAT.
